

Announce Lederle Faculty Awards

PEARL RIVER, N. Y.—Grants totalling \$235,612 have been made by American Cyanamid Co., here, to thirteen outstanding medical school teachers and researchers for the 1957 Lederle Medical Faculty Awards, the company has announced.
